



GOOD BEHAVIOUR CHARTER

Our '**Good Behaviour Charter**' represents sensible rules of conduct, which will help the enjoyment of your own party, and other holidaymakers.

- Unreasonable and or offensive behaviour, fighting, or acts of malicious damage by any individual in the group will not be tolerated under any circumstances and may well result in the entire party being asked to leave the hotel or holiday park without entitlement to refund. **You could also lose your damage deposit of £250.00 - (£500.00 for under 15 teams).**
- In the event of damage to property or injury, the hotel or holiday park management will have the right to demand appropriate compensation from the entire group. **You could also lose your damage deposit of £250.00 - (£500.00 for under 15 teams).**
- Be considerate of other guests and keep the noise down. Especially at night.
- In the event of any disturbance made by members of your group, the hotel or holiday park management reserves the right to demand compensation for other guests and may ask for your removal from the premises. **You could also lose your damage deposit of £250.00 - (£500.00 for under 15 teams).**
- Please do not allow children in the party to wander around the site unsupervised. This is particularly important in the evenings.
- Please ensure that there is a responsible adult available to supervise your party at all times.
- Please do not allow children to play ball games around the accommodation – please ensure children play football in a suitable area on the park.

REMEMBER - In the United Kingdom it is illegal for children under the age of 18 to purchase and/or consume alcohol.

1. Do not allow children who are below the legal age for the consumption of alcohol to purchase alcohol for their consumption or to consume alcohol, which has been purchased by an adult.
2. Do not allow adults to purchase alcohol on behalf of a child or supply them with alcohol.
3. Any group whose children are discovered attempting to purchase or consume alcohol may be asked to leave the hotel or Holiday Park.
4. Any adult who purchases alcohol for a child WILL be asked to leave the Holiday Park.
5. Alcohol abuse is unacceptable, and could result in the removal of persons, or your whole party from the site.
6. Please do not allow **anyone** to consume alcohol at pitchside during the tournament.

NB: The majority of Under 15 teams are well behaved and pose no problem whilst attending our tournaments. However a small minority of teams have made it necessary for us to increase the amount of Damage Deposit taken for Under 15 teams. It is regrettable that a large damage deposit has become necessary, however failure to take this would result in the Holiday Parks not allowing Under 15 teams to attend our tournaments. We are sure you will understand this.

Please ensure every member of group is aware of the requirements of this charter.
